

**Date:** 6 May 2014. Black Sugarloaf, Birrale (big tree track).

**Habitat:** Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

**Substrate:** Wood of decaying eucalypt (big tree log).

**Description:** Scattered stalked mostly erect, globose or prolate sporangia 1.7–2 mm high. **Sporotheca** globose, 0.7 mm diameter. **Stalk** grooved, cylindrical, black at base grading to reddish at apex, 0.9–1.2 mm long. **Hypothallus** discoid and contiguous under groups, reddish brown. **Peridial net** strong reddish ribs extending from base to near the top of the sporotheca where the ribs merge into an irregular net in some sporangia. **Spores** reddish brown in mass, light by transmitted light with pale warts, 6  $\mu$ m.

**Notes:** Extensive colony but most sporangia were mouldy.
